### **LOCAL SPORTING CHAMPIONS**

The Local Sporting Champions program is an Australian Government initiative designed to provide financial assistance for young people aged 12-18 years towards the cost of travel, accommodation, uniforms or equipment when competing, coaching or officiating at an official national sporting organisation endorsed state, national or international sporting championships or a School Sport Australia state or national championships

### **CLUB ONE (SA) LIMITED SPONSORSHIP**

Club One (SA) Limited makes small sponsorships available to community clubs and associations on a regular basis and has, during the past 18 months allocated more than \$100,000 to South Australian clubs and associations. To be eligible for a sponsorship applicant clubs and associations cannot operate gaming machines on their premises.

Small sponsorships are considered every one to two months, and announced regularly throughout the year. Small sponsorships are to a maximum of \$500.

To apply for a Small Sponsorship please write to the Executive Officer Club One either by email or by letter outlining the request and a summary of the Club and what would be the benefits for the community/group of getting a \$500 sponsorship.

Community Benefit SA provides support for vulnerable South Australian individuals, families and communities by funding organisations to deliver practical one-off projects to buy essential equipment or help organisations grow and develop. Under the guidelines organisations can apply for one-off grants for the following:

- Equipment purchases to support community services or programs
- Upgrade or renovation of facilities where community services or programs are conducted
- One off delivery of short term programs, services or community development activities for disadvantage people
- Strategic improvements for community service provider
